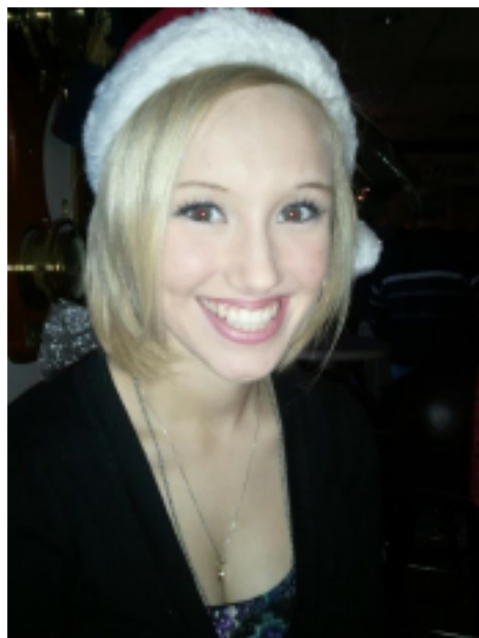

(Let us know if your insurance changes in the future.)

Requests for a dock, both from previous dock holders and from new applicants, must be submitted by January 31, 2012. The assignment committee will honor requests for a new slip/location as best as possible. However, in order to make best use of the harbor we may assign slips based on size, i.e. large boat = large dock, small boat = small dock. Docks will not be assigned to members not in good standing i.e. has not completed the requisite hours in the previous year or is past due on dues or fees. Dock fees must be paid in full by the due date on the invoice and prior to launching boat.

Note - If you submit a dock application and then turn it down once dock assignments have been made you will be billed a \$100 fee.

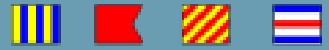
