Due to potential water level issues this coming spring, it will be more important to turn in Dock Applications by "mid February" because that is when the dock assignment committee will be meeting. Any requests for dock changes should be noted at the bottom of the application so they can be discussed at this dock assignment committee meeting.



Floaters who would like a permanent dock should also submit dock applications to keep their rank on the floaters list because it is one factor in determining who gets the docks when they become available.

If our harbor water levels continue to drop, the GBYC risks losing boats to other deeper marinas. At the dock assignment committee meeting we will be looking at our options to avoid or minimize such situations. For example, do we have any dock holders with "smaller draft" boats in "deeper draft" slips who would "temporally" swap docks with a another dock holder who needs more draft until the water levels come up again?

Regular members that are permanent dock holders need to put in a minimum of 18 hours of work time during the previous calendar year or buy their hours at \$25/hr. If you are unsure about your hours, the membership hours list is located in one of the top drawers just below the big screen TV in the bar area. Also, if any current dock holders plan to give up their dock for 2013 for whatever reason such as selling their boat, please let me know.






