

There is a strong probability that we will fill all our docks this year. We only have two open docks at the time of this writing. We also have members on the floaters list. To accommodate floaters I will really need dock holders to enter their departure and return dates in the dock holder's book when leaving our harbor for multi day cruises. Actually, I



would really appreciate getting a phone call regarding the same information. My cell phone number is 920-366-1123. If you don't reach me, please leave a message including your name, dock number, departure and return dates.

Our fuel tank and underground fuel line have been checked and passed inspection. Please note that only authorized personnel are allowed to pump gas. This August a new code will require the GBYC to have one member who is trained and certified to pump gas. The certification class is 8 hours long. The certified member can then train other club members so they can also pump gas.

Changes to any written rule must be brought up at a general meeting for discussion, then tabled and posted in the following month's newsletter. Changes can then be voted on. Changes that effect the daily operation of the GBYC can be made by the GBYC board of directors at anytime.






