Check your phone number in the dock log to see if it's correct so we don't call the wrong number if there is a problem with your boat or it needs to be moved.

Fleet Captain - Don Smith

As of April 21st we had only 5 open docks! This year we may fill all our docks and a floaters list will become more active. Any full members who do not currently have docks at the GBYC, but may want one some day, should get on the floaters list because one of the factors that determines which floaters get a dock is their length of time on the floater list.



If the floaters list becomes active again, it will be very important that permanent dock holders record their boat departure and return dates in the dock book before leaving for extended periods.

The grounds crew cleaned up the storage area for jack stands, blocking, etc. and it looks good. We are asking members that use this area during the boating season to put their names on anything they put into that area. You can use a magic marker, paint, wood burner, etc. Tosca also provided new boards for use under jack stands. Your old boards should be placed near the GBYC fire pit or next to the wood pile.

Dock holders should check the dock holder's book to make sure the phone numbers are correct and write in any additional numbers that can be called in an emergency. Many boats sink at the dock due to failed sea water hoses & connections, muskrats chewing through rubber seals on stern drives, etc. Several years ago, I was at the GBYC when we noticed that the stern drive of a boat was totally submerged. We called the owner and he was able to get to his boat and correct the problem before the engine was submerged.

Again, remember to unplug your land-bound boat when not on GBYC property.



Organization of shed is getting better. Still need to organize tool room, contact me if you can help.


Special thanks to Evil for building us a cabinet for the tool room for spare parts, really a high quality cabinet!


