# **Greetings from the Commodore** - Larry Labine

With another warm boating season coming to an end, I think the club has headed in the right direction with the docks just about full and new members on the rise. The board has been doing all they can to cut costs and labor to build up our bank account and now we ask our dock holders to only run your heat and air when you are on your boats. Turn your water heaters off when you you don't need hot water. Our utility bill in August was over



\$4,100 mostly due to cooling the club and boats. If we keep our electrical cost down on the docks we can help keep our dock fees down. There are several dock holders that don't even use any power and they pay the same rate per foot as everyone else. So let's be fair to them and try to conserve whenever possible. We have looked into putting meters on the docks but they cost \$29 per meter and it could be a nightmare for the Fleet Captain to monitor them when floaters move into someones dock or someone plugs into your meter when boats are stored on shore.

It has been a pleasure working with the present board. We seemed to work together and not on opposing sides on issues. We will be replacing a few next year so we are looking for anyone who would like to be on next year's board of directors. If you are interested please contact Pat Foley or myself.



- \* Check aerators pull out any sticks or garbage.


# **Yacht Club Input Committee**


