Greetings from the Commodore - Larry Labine



Fall is in the air and the boats are starting to lift out for the winter. Make sure you have your storage application filled out and payment made before lifting. Tom Nies is in charge of the lift crews this year and has done a great job of meeting with the crews and going over some safety concerns and daily checks on the lift. If the crews say your boat is not blocked properly they have the final say. In the past few years they have seen blocking snap in half and many other things that are unsafe. Make sure your boat is pumped out and your blocking and stands are ready when the crews lift your boat. Also sign up for your lift at least 24 hours in advance. If anyone would like to get on a lift crew call Tom. It is a great way to get your hours in and meet some great people.

There is still several members that have no hours in for this year. Most of the members that have no hours are new members and we have many ways to get them in such as monthly Smokers which is a night that different members each month cook a meal for the men and there guests. It is done all by volunteers with the profits from them we purchase kitchen equipment when needed and the last one in May is free or reduced based on how many you attend. If you have any cooking skills and would like to help or head up a Smoker contact Gary Kuschel. Another way to get hours is a party like Autumn Fest that is the 29th of September if it's not too late by the time you read this. Dock day will be on the 20th of October at 8 AM till noon which is a good way to get hours.

Pool Night FAQ's.

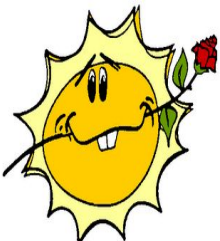
1. When do they play? [Every Tuesday, 6:30 PM, From "Dock's out" to "Dock's in" for the new season.]
