Greetings from the Commodore - Larry Labine



With vacations settling down and kids back in school the harbor is getting full of boats again. Just a reminder to sign in and out of your dock so others can use them when they're open. Don't wait until the last day to get your 18 hours in volunteering at the club for all the regular members. You can work on Smokers, Dock days, parties, travel lift crews, dock repairs, snow removal, bar tending, or many other ways to get them in. By those members doing the work we help keep down the cost of maintaining the Club or else we need to hire someone to do it for us and that's what being in a club is all about. Collin will have a list of grounds work that needs to be done also.

We had a meeting with the company that is doing the dredging of the PCB's in the river and we'll be getting our harbor done sometime in the next 2 to 3 years. They will be doing some sampling in the next few months. In the past we could not dredge the amount and where we needed to because of the PCB's concentration in our harbor. We would have had to dewater the contaminates and haul them to Beaver Dam which makes it very very expensive. We should have an 8 foot depth throughout the harbor when completed. This process will take about a week to complete from when they get the equipment here until completion. They will be doing this in early spring before the harbor opens or fall after the harbor is shut down for the year. We will be moving the docks all to one side of the harbor to dredge and then move the docks to the completed side to do the other side. They come into the harbor with a barge with a vacuum system that sucks the mud up and pumps it into the barge and hauls it up river to a building where they burn it and then use it for fill.

We will be having our Autumn fest which is our last outdoor party of the year on September 24th. Jeff Tilkins will be heading the party. We will have a live band and plenty of food. Come on out for the party and stay on your boats. We delayed the party later this year so that our members that have docks up north can attend. Thank you Jeff for all the work you put in as Entertainment Chairman over the last several years.

Over the next 3 months we will be looking for new members to run for the board. Pat Foley has asked to be on the Nominating Committee. So if you have some extra time and would like to become a board member let Pat or another board member know of your interest.

The Packers are playing again and the Yacht Club is the second best place in Green Bay to watch the games. We have 5 TV's with the games on and we have Happy Hour prices for all Packer games. Just bring a snack or dish to pass and enjoy another great Packer season.

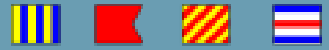
