We had WPS remove all of the light poles and thanks to Dave Lehulier for putting all the new lights on the buildings and on the poles on the south side. He did most of this on the hottest days of the year. We had only one person complain about it but he got over it. If you feel that you need more light somewhere let me know. This will save us over \$15,000 per year. Thanks also to Dean for the lights.. Dean also put a button on the outside of the box on the gate so you can get out if you are walking or on a bike.

The Winter Storage applications should be in this newsletter or off our website and should be sent to Don Smith A.S.A.P. with a certificate of insurance and a check. You must be signed up on the lift log 24 hours in advance to let the Travel lift crews know how to plan the next day. Have your blocking and jack stand ready. We can not store boats that are no blocked properly.

Thanks Captain Mitch from the Foxy Lady for giving us a great deal again this year for the trip on the 23rd from noon til 3 PM with the pick up at the boat landing next door. The cost is \$10 per person with the maximum of 130 people. Bring your friends and family. ## Fleet Captain - Don Smith

Our docks are full at this time. If you are a full member and think you may want a dock someday, you should fill out a dock application to get on the floater list. If a dock becomes available, one of the factors used to determine who gets it is your length of time (rank) on the floater list.



We are still having issues with boat trailers! There are still 6 boat trailers on GBYC property without stickers and 3 trailers with expired stickers. Contact me or Jay to get your stickers. Cost is \$75 + tax. (\$79.13)

Boat cradles are not allowed on GBYC property. One of our new members, Bret Boehm,

(dock 83) can make jack stands at a "very" reasonable cost. He can be reached at 920-792-8871.

We are not selling fuel for boats at this time. Our gasoline tank is nearly empty and what is left is being saved for the travel lift. If we bought 4000 gal at current prices, we would have to sell it for over \$4.40/gal.

We will start lifting boats for winter storage on Sept 21st and end on Oct 18th. If you need hours or just want to be on one of the four lift crews, contact Tom Nies at 920-676-3145. IMPORTANT: to have your boat lifted you must sign in on the lift book at least 24 hours in advance of the lift.

NOTE: Dock holders and all members using harbor privileges (including trailer storage, etc.) must have 18 hours of GBYC work time per year. At this time we have several dock holders that have little to no hours. Members who are short on hours will be billed after Jan 1st @ \$18/hr for the hours needed to reach the previous year's 18 hr requirement.

Dock Day has been scheduled for October 20th.

# Pool Night FAQ's.


- **1.** When do they play? [Every Tuesday, 6:30 PM, From "Dock's out" to "Dock's in" for the new season.]
