#### Fleet Captain - Don Smith

Fleet Captain Report - September 2013

In early August we purchased a half load of gasoline to get us through this season. The cost at our pump is \$3.98/gal.

We will start lifting boats for winter storage on Friday Sept 20th and end lifting on Thursday Oct 17th. Tom Nies will be in charge of the lift crews. If you need work hours, contact Tom at 920-676-3145. IMPORTANT: members must sign in on the Lift Book at least 24 hours prior to the lift!

This season we had much better compliance with trailer storage fees. 27 members paid the fee (\$75+tax) and were issued seasonal trailer stickers. However, there still are 5 trailers without stickers or with expired stickers. In 2013 our trailers stickers started at number 398. I took pictures of the trailers that are not in compliance and plan to put locks on them.

Note: all members using harbor privileges (including trailer storage, etc.) must put in 18 hours of GBYC work time per calendar year. If they are short on hours at the end of the year, they will be billed after Jan 1st at \$18/hr for the hours needed to reach the previous year's 18 hr requirement.

Dock day is tentatively scheduled for Saturday Oct 19th.



Please keep your boat area picked up so we don't. have to stop and move things to mow and trim.


We could use some help with the yard work. Let Pete or I know if you would like to help or need hours.
