Dock Day went smoothly with nice weather, a good crew, good food and free drinks. Harbor water levels were about the same as on our dock day this past spring.

This will help the GBYC to collect unpaid fees. Also note that there has been some discussion among some board members regarding adding a "late fee charge" that could be added to fees paid after the deadline. This idea will be brought-up at our November board meeting.
