Docks will not be assigned to members not in good standing, i.e. has not completed the requisite hours in the previous year or is past due on dues or fees. **Dock fee must be paid in full by the due date on the invoice and prior to launching boat.**

**Note - If you submit a dock application and then turn it down once dock assignments have been made you will be billed a \$100 fee.**

# The Life Saver

Safety on Land and Water



## THIS MONTH: HYPOTHERMIA

Hypothermia occurs when your body loses heat faster than it can produce heat, causing a dangerously low body temperature. Normal body temperature is around 98.6 F (37 C). Hypothermia occurs as your body temperature passes below 95 F. When your body temperature drops, your heart, nervous system and other organs can't work correctly. Left untreated, hypothermia can eventually lead to complete failure of your heart and respiratory system and to death. Hypothermia is most often caused by exposure to cold weather or immersion in a cold body of water. Primary treatments for hypothermia are methods to warm the body back to a normal temperature. Here are some common signs of Hypothermia:

Shivering  
Slow, shallow breathing.  
Confusion and memory loss.  
Drowsiness or exhaustion.  
Slurred or mumbled speech.  
Loss of coordination, fumbling hands, stumbling steps.  
A slow, weak pulse.

In severe hypothermia, a person may be unconscious without signs of breathing or a pulse. Avoid rapid rewarming of hypothermia victims because cold blood rushing to the heart and other vital organs may be detrimental. Here are a few steps to provide medical care prior to seeking professional medical care:

1. Remove any wet clothes, hats, gloves, shoes, and socks.
2. Begin rewarming the person with extra clothing. Use warm blankets. Other helpful items for warming are: an electric blanket to the torso area and hot packs and heating pad on the torso, armpits, neck, and groin; however, these can cause burns to the skin. Use your own body heat if nothing else is available.
3. Take the person's temperature if a thermometer is available.
4. Offer warm liquids, but avoid alcohol and caffeine, which speed up heat loss. Don't try to give fluids to an unconscious person.
