April 15th Tax Day § Strange Tax Facts

* A "tax" is defined by the *Collins English Dictionary* as a "compulsory financial contribution imposed by a government to raise revenue...."

- At the close of the federal government's 2012 fiscal year, the federal government had \$67.7 trillion in debts, liabilities, and unfinanced obligations for current Social Security and Medicare participants. This equates to \$215,311 for every person living in the U.S. or \$559,331 per household.
- Indiana: Kit Kat and Twix bars are tax-free but Nestle Crunch bars are taxable
