Festivus, a well-celebrated <u>parody</u>, has become a <u>secular</u> holiday celebrated on December 23 that serves as an alternative to participating in the pressures and <u>commercialism</u> of the <u>Christmas</u> season. Originally a family tradition of scriptwriter <u>Dan O'Keefe</u>, who <u>worked</u> on the American sitcom <u>Seinfeld</u>, the holiday entered popular culture after it was made the focus of <u>a 1997 episode</u> of the program. The holiday's celebration, as it was shown on <u>Seinfeld</u>, includes a Festivus dinner, an unadorned <u>aluminum</u> Festivus pole, practices such as the "Airing of <u>Grievances</u>" and "Feats of Strength", and the labeling of easily explainable events as "Festivus miracles". The <u>episode</u> refers to it as "a Festivus for the rest of us", referencing its non-commercial aspect. It has also been described both as a "<u>parody</u> holiday festival" and as a form of playful consumer resistance.


