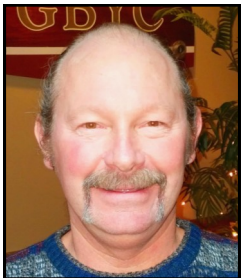
Happy April!

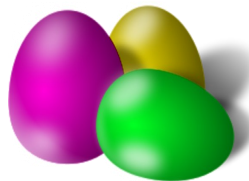
