

### Exciting times ahead

Your lighthouses are enjoying the summer in the glimmer of the late sunsets and the 6<sup>th</sup> order Fresnel lenses. We have some exciting things coming up. We will be celebrating Dave Nelson's birthday Tuesday, July 14<sup>th</sup> with an open house at the lighthouses (his birthday is July 5<sup>th.</sup>) All members are invited and encouraged to come on out if only for a little while to wish Dave a happy birthday and thank him for all he has done for the Club over the years. Yes, there will be cake.

We have a couple of visits from the United States Light House Society coming up. On Sunday, July 19<sup>th</sup> an upper Peninsula of Michigan lighthouse tour is stopping at our lighthouses as their last stop before flying out of Austin Straubel. On Monday, August 3<sup>rd</sup> we will be the first stop for their scheduled Door County tour. We are excited to be a part of their tours.

On August 8<sup>th</sup> the Green Bay Mike & Key Club will be hosting an event at the lighthouses. The Amateur Radio (Ham) operators are licensed to transmit on certain frequencies. Besides providing emergency communication for the County, assisting with medical communications at walks and runs and weather spotting, we find ways of practicing to communicate. One of the ways is by promoting an event. All this is done as volunteers. What we are planning to do is to promote the two Grassy Island Range lights at the Yacht Club. We call this a "Special Event". In a national radio magazine and international web site, we list the Event giving the date, time, location and frequency. On that day, we transmit calling sending" Grassy Island Range Lights Special Event." Other operators would contact us and we will log their information. When they send us a self addressed stamped envelope we will send them a certificate with the contact information and history of the Lights.
