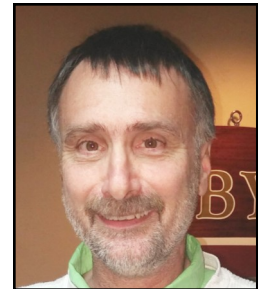

Greetings from the Commodore Gary Kuschel

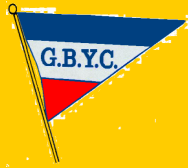

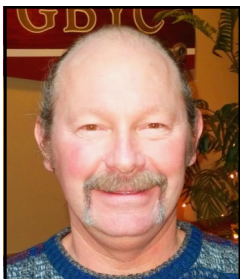
