





# Grassy Island Range Lights, Inc.

On Saturday, August 8th, the Green Bay Mike and Key Club set up their Emergency Communications Trailer between the lighthouses to commemorate the 10th anniversary of the dedication of the Grassy Island Range Lights, a day after National Lighthouse Day.

With overcast skies throughout the 9AM to 1PM event, the radio conditions faded in and out. When good, contacts were made in New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, Kentucky, Arkansas, Texas and California as well as others. A Connecticut contact, affiliated with the Amateur Radio Lighthouse Society indicated that the Grassy Island Lighthouses had never been activated before on the radio and is one that is sought out. The first weekend of August is Lighthouse Special Event Weekend all over the USA.

August was a busy month at the lighthouses with another visit from the United States Light House Society. One of the visitors was Wayne Wheeler, President of the USLHS. In his comments left in the guest register he stated "Beautiful and accurately restored, Bravo!" Its pretty exciting when the President, who stated he visits about 50 lighthouses a year, gave your lighthouses such high praise. And an unexpected visit of 50-60 children from South Korea in Wisconsin for an "English as a Second Language" program. The children were a rambunctious bunch and most were quite interested in the lighthouses and their history, and others just there for fun. Again in 2015, along with <u>Yachtoberfest</u> we will have an open house at the lighthouses. The time will be from 1PM to 5PM on Saturday, October 3rd. Please let your friends and neighbors know. We do not charge admission for the lighthouse tours unlike many other lighthouses, so it is a good deal.
