### Grassy Island Range Lights, Inc.

Lighthouses are beacons in the night for those out at sea. They ensure that boats enter harbors safely and serve as markers for hazardous coastlines. For this purpose, the Grassy Island Range Lights were commissioned by Congress in 1866, the lights were built in 1872 on Grassy Island, 1.5 miles north of their present location. In 1966 they were transported from the island to the north side our yacht club harbor. They were moved to their current site in 1999 when the "Lighthouse Keepers" began restoration. Each structure is lit with a sixth-order Fresnel lens. The lights were placed on the State of Wisconsin Register of Historic Sites on October 15, 2004 and the National Register of Historic Places on November 5, 2005. Where do old lighthouses go to retire? How about the Green Bay Yachting Club? We are privileged to be the retirement home for these stalwart fixtures. And no Medicare. Contributions accepted.






