

Well the harbor is filling up nicely and the GBYC grounds are alive with the sound of the TRAVEL-LIFT putting boats in the harbor and the tearing of shrink wrap. I apologize for omitting in last month's article my thanks and gratitude to Ken Unrath, Paul Butin and Mark Wolf for their work on the well and our water system, once again "Great job guys"! BREAKING NEWS!....The fuel system is up and running, with all issues resolved. Thanks to some great work on the part of some hard working and dedicated individuals, you know who are, and thank you!

GBYC is now selling 91 Octane Premium Fuel with no additives, current price at the pump is \$2.90. (This is a Great Price). With us moving to 91 Octane Premium Fuel, this will greatly benefit GBYC members by providing your boat with better detonation, better fuel economy and better performance from your boat. To those GBYC slip holders that require Diesel Fuel, I ask that all fueling of your boat take place in the well at the fuel dock. The fuel dock is where all the contamination and fire safety equipment is located and we need to be in compliance with all local and state laws. You may have noticed that Brennan (The Dredging Crew) now has their boats in the harbor. They are located out by the Light Houses and will be coming and going 24 hours a day, and parking their trucks on the south side in the gravel area. Ed Hausen is the lead project engineer and is a great guy, please make his crew feel welcome and say "Hello"....they may pop in on burger night or taco night once in a while. This is a great opportunity for GBYC to have a pulse on the dredging project and Ed has assured me that he will work together with GBYC on getting our harbor dredged and will even assist us in moving our docks during the dredging while at the same time as much as possible allowing our dock holders to have a full 2017 boating season. I know everyone is concerned about this, so this is great news and a win...win for GBYC, so say hello to the Brennan crew. NOTICE: There is now 2 signs on the dock attendant shack, they state the following: Absolutely NO use of Toxic or Acid Based Cleaning Chemicals while boat is in the TRAVEL-LIFT slings. This is extremely important and please take note that we now have new slings on the TRAVEL-LIFT and these chemicals severely damage the slings. Thanks! Finally,...as always please properly dispose of your shrink-wrap, waste oil and lubricants, and old batteries. Well, let's hope Mother Nature turns things around soon for us and gives us some sunshine! I wish everyone a "Happy Memorial Day!"...and stay safe, take care and see you at the club!


