

**Watch the Packer Games at the Club**

Here we are, September. Interesting summer. Rain anybody? You may have noticed the scaffolding on the South side of the North lighthouse. Water intrusion has caused part of our once pristine lighthouse to turn to mush. Fortunately only a small portion has been damaged and will be restored by the end of the month (according to the plan.) If you recall from the August calendar in the Dockline, August 7 was National Lighthouse Day. On the Saturday before, the Green Bay Mike & Key Club and the members of the Amateur Radio Light House Society were at your Grassy Island Light Houses for the radio event. Known as USA334H and USA339H, the Lighthouses On The Air event communicated with others in 35 states and 2 providences in Canada. In total, there were 112 confirmed contacts, including 7 other lighthouses in 3.75 hours. It was a fun experience. We are nearing the chronological end of the campaign to raise the 3 million dollar goal for the project to stabilize the breakwall upon which your lighthouses stand. A couple of GBYC members have stepped up to help us reach our goal. We expected the membership would see the need and chip in. We are a long way away from the necessary funds needed to get the job done. And your donations are tax deductible. There are blank donation forms in the Lighthouse mail slot. We can print more. Or talk to Ruthi McMonagle, Merlin Baenen, Dick Heinz, John Kennedy or Wayne Dunbar for details and how you can help. Don't be bashful :-)



**Please Note:** "Aerators have been placed around the harbor to keep the water moving. ALL members are responsible for keeping these aerators clean and the water moving. There is no aerator committee and it's not the responsibility of the gas attendants. So as you are walking on the docks please take note of how the aerator is operating. Shake it, unplug it, do what you need to in order to keep the branches and seaweed and plastic bags out of it. If you are unable to get it cleaned out, unplug it and contact a board member to have it looked at. These units cost about \$500 each and running with debris stuck in them will ruin them. So again, PLEASE just pay attention to them."

Well, I hope everyone is having an enjoyable 2017 boating season and getting to all your intended destinations safely. The new members continue to pour into the Green Bay Yacht Club. So if you see a new face, say "hello" and introduce yourself. We recently also filled the fuel tank with fresh fuel and we were able to maintain our current price of \$2.90 per gallon ( 91 Octane / No Additives ). I am also sure you all have heard, if you receive the Duck-O-Gram, that the Brennan Dredge Crew will be conducting dredging operations in the area of the G.B.Y.C. Harbor for the rest of the boating season.

They ask if you could please hail them on channel 16 or they can be reached @ (608)792-6591. Please hail or call them to ensure safe passage into or out of the G.B.Y.C. harbor and that there are no obstructions under the surface of the water that your vessel may hit (i.e. cable etc.) Most of the time you are going to be clear to pass, just give them a heads up. The hours of operation are 24 hours a day, starting a 0700 hrs. on Monday and going until 0700 hrs. on Saturday. So, from 0700 hrs. Saturday morning until Monday morning @ 0700 you will be fine. If you are planning on storing your boat at G.B.Y.C. for the 2017-2018 winter storage season please fill out an application and get it to me with a check in the next few weeks, please so I can plan accordingly. NOTICE: 'Mark this Date!' DOCK DAY IS OCTOBER 21st! I also have met with Tom Nies on lift crew assignments to start in September. There will also be a lift crew safety meeting. So watch for that date to come out soon. It will be in the Duck-O-Gram and also be posted at the club along with your lift crew chief being notified, and he will in turn notify you. The good news is that I recently met with Ed Hausen of Brennan this week and he stated to me that the above noted 'Dock Day' will be fine with any intended dredging operations, so all of our members will have a full 2017 Boating Season. Well, that's all I have for now. So.....everyone take care, stay safe!...and see you at the club! I am OUT!!!


