





With winds of 67mph and typhoon like conditions in the harbor, it created some upheaval with the high water conditions again. With much debris being spread around and in the G.B.Y.C. harbor, so please be careful. This has been a troublesome year weather wise and with a lot of construction going on, I want to thank everyone for your patience and understanding. We still manage to have plenty of fun and good times. Just a heads up, we are getting quotes on shore retention for the rest of the harbor. John Kennedy once again is doing an outstanding job spearheading this project. Fall Dock Day and the lift crews may be slightly tweaked. Stayed tuned. shouldn't be much of an issue, but will be similar to when we moved the docks for dredging. I recently purchased fuel. Current price at the pump is \$3.60, 91 Octane with no additives. I have been receiving complaints on members not taking care of their waste materials when working on their various vessels., batteries waste oil ... etc. Remember it must leave the grounds and be disposed of properly. I am having signs made for around the harbor grounds. This will be the boat owners responsibility if any expense is occurred by G.B.Y.C. on cleanup or D.N.R. violations. If you need a trailer sticker please see me, I see there are a few trailers, small boats and jet ski's on the grounds, they are required to have a G.B.Y.C. permit / decal to be on the grounds. So please see me for one. Notice: Reminder to all G.B.Y.C. members, you must be on the grounds at G.B.Y.C. if you have your boat plugged in to charge your boats electrical system, even if your vessel is on shore and or jackstands. This is a hard and fast rule, is for the safety and preservation of all members and will be enforced. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter. Well, that's all I have for now, please take care and stay safe!..... I'll see you at the club!I am out!!!
