

Greetings from the Commodore Kris Johnson



Grassy Island Range Lights



You would think that a lighthouse keeper would get the original date of the Grassy Island Range Lights activation right wouldn't you. The last article stated 1873. The brass plaque on the south lighthouse states 1872. DAH! So be it. Since 1872 there has been a lot of activity with the 2 structures, including where and how they stand today. They have been included as the background for a local television news station, on the cover page of a local governments annual report, and other publications. And they are owned by the Green Bay Yachting Club! Yes, that's right. The yacht club owns the lighthouses.

The lighthouses have been a part of the club since 1960's. Many club members have been involved with the lights, from their becoming club property to where they are today. For 147 years they have been a part of the maritime heritage of Green Bay. Today they stand as a reminder of how Green Bay has evolved as a commercial port. We as recreational boaters use the buoys and lights that mark the channel into the Port of Green Bay. Looking back, they were an integral part of making our city what it is. Often, from the walkway of the South light one is eyeball to eyeball to the bridge of the ships that enter the port.



Have you been out to the lights? Walked around them and looked up and considered how, in 1873 the lighthouse keepers hauled oil up the stairs to keep the lights lit through the night. We as a club have the privilege of owning and maintaining these historical structures. Grab a beverage and snack and go out to the lights. Sit at one of the picnic tables and relish the peace and tranquility they provide. Or come on out on Tuesday night and give a helping hand. "Come on down."
