## Join our Lighthouse Docents for rewarding activities and fun!

How about becoming a Grassy Island Range Lights Docent?

We are starting a program within the Grassy Island Range Lights whereby volunteers would, on a scheduled basis provide access to the Welcome Center and the lighthouses.

We would require at least 2 people each time period that the access is available. That could be you and a family member, a friend or fellow enthusiast. Suggested open times would be, Saturday and Sunday from 10AM to 5PM. As Tuesday night is work night for lighthouse keepers, that day could also be included from 4PM to 7PM. Other days and times could be arranged but prefer regular days and hours.

We would provide a cell phone unique to the Grassy Island Range Lights that a prospective visitor would call to gain access to the lights using the digital gate access. We would put a message on the phone with hours and directions to the lights. The phone would need to stay in the Welcome Center, or with the guide if not in the Welcome Center.

Volunteers (you?) would go through a screening process same as members of the Yacht Club to ensure ok, then given a gate card for entry. Training would be required.
