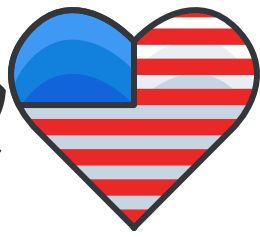

**Hello GBYC !!**

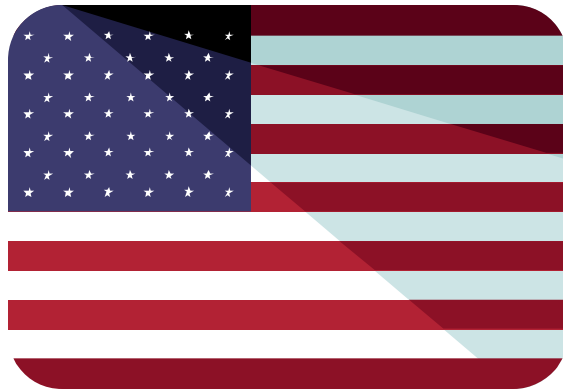
Thank You to all that prepped the club for the Bash!!

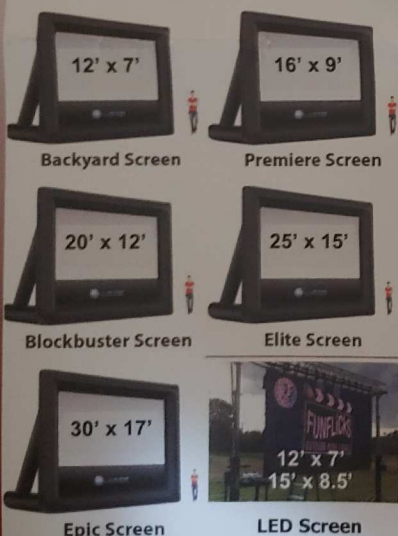
