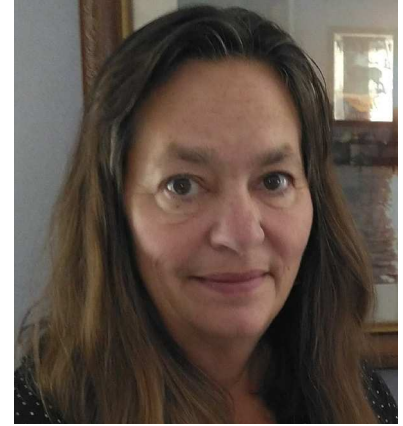

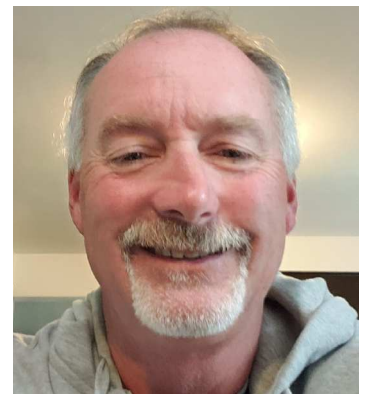
I would like to thank you for your support and am looking forward to this upcoming year of serving as your Commodore. As time goes on, I'll have more to say but that's it for now.

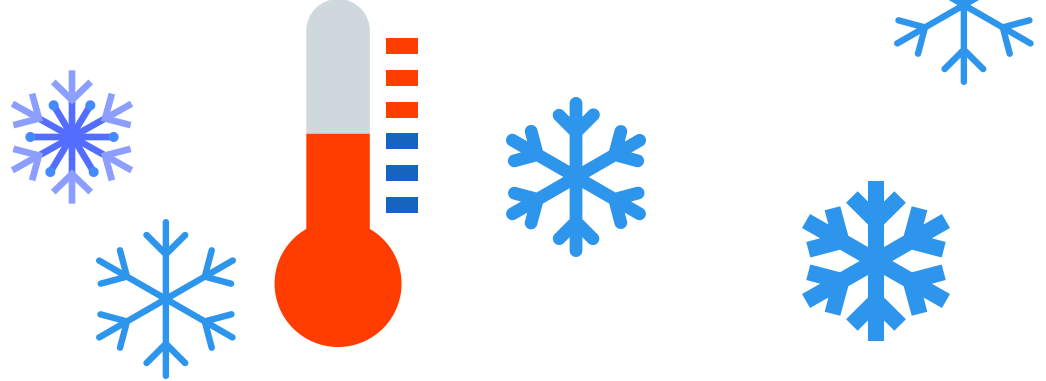

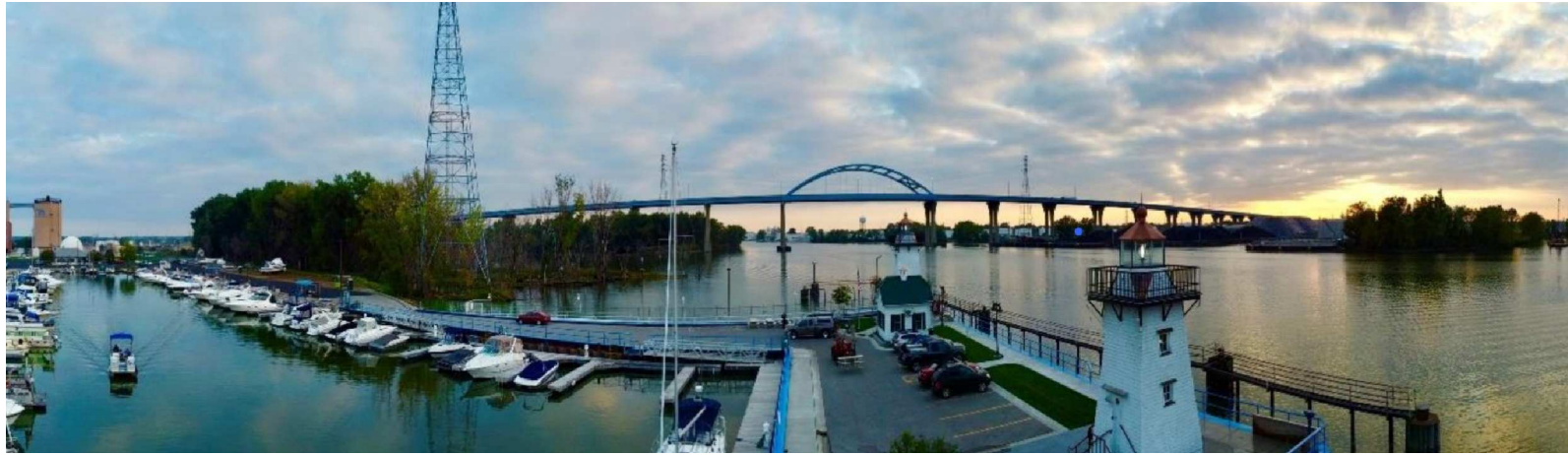

Grassy Island Range Lights
