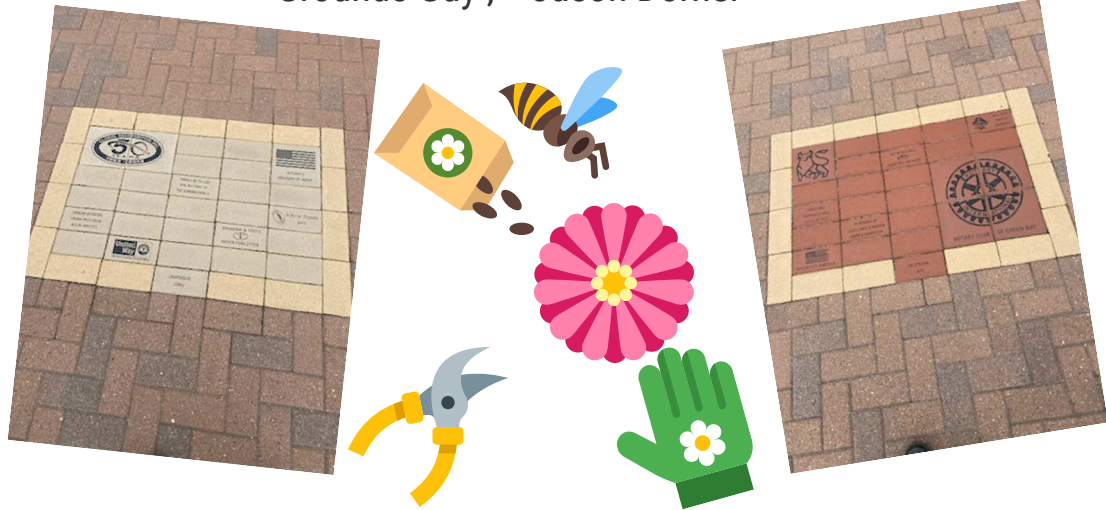
Another successful dock day !! Thanks to all and tgeir efforts. Docks are in, and soon all the boats will be too !!

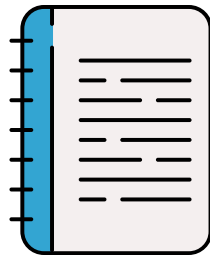

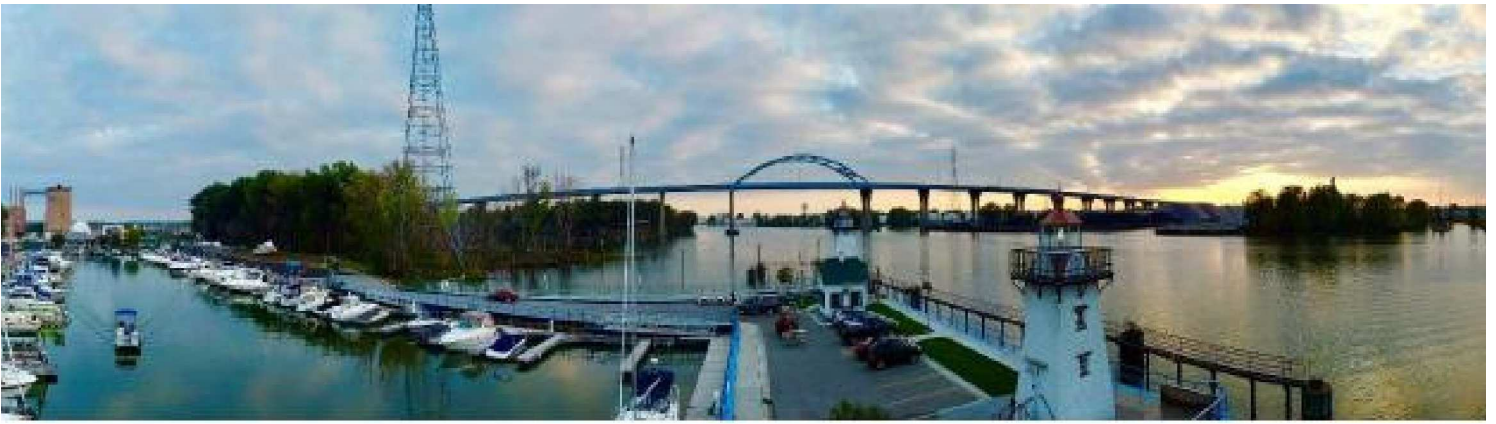

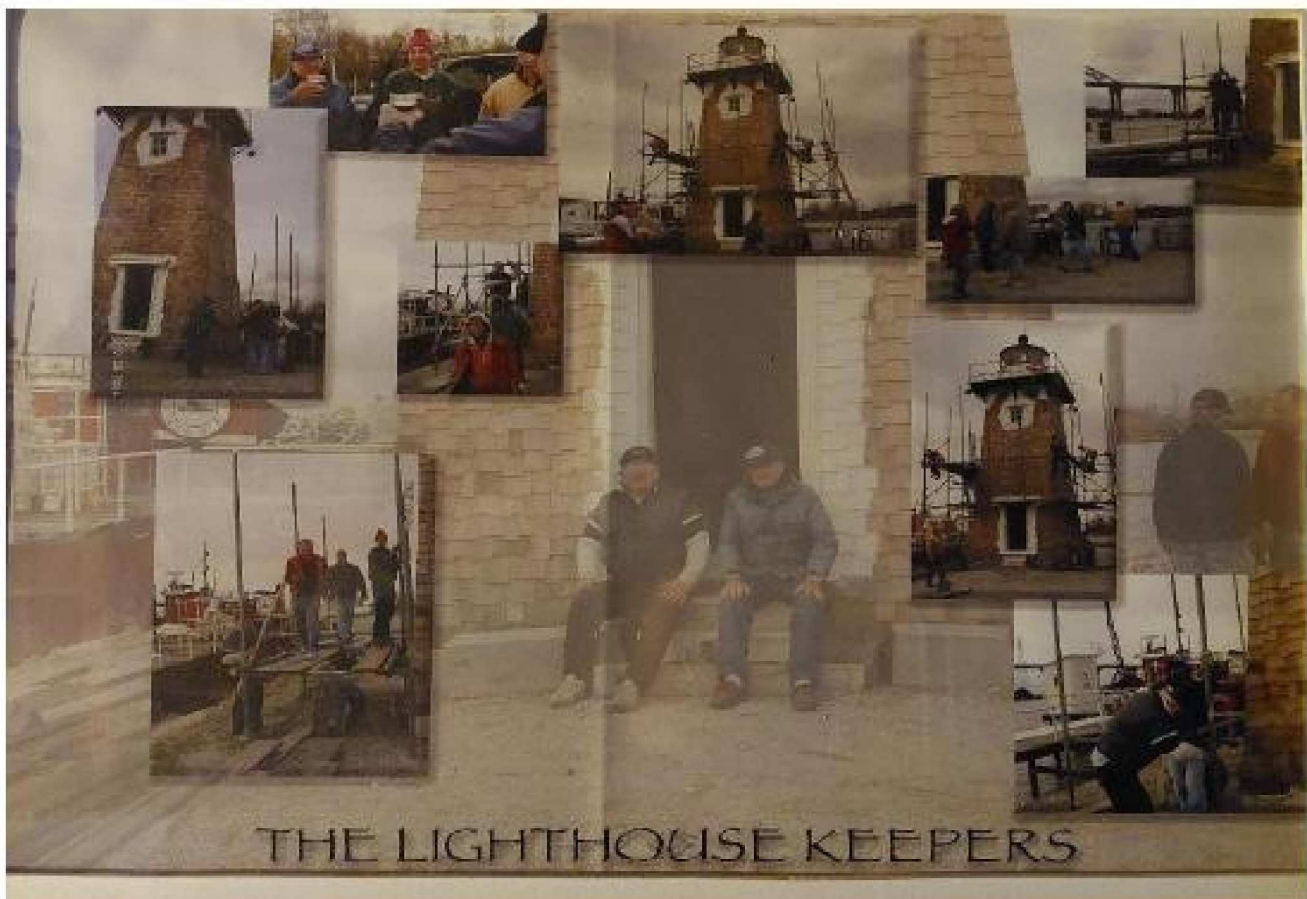
