Last month was a very productive and good month for club cash flow as very nearly all of this year's Seasonal Dock Renters got their payments made on time (or just about on time)! So thanks to all of you conscientious members who care enough about our club to make on-time payments.

May 1st was also the published due date for Trailer Storage applications/fees to have been submitted to the club. So if you have a trailer in the lot and have not yet made payment on this, please do so ASAP. Here's a link to the form: <https://tinyurl.com/5xcvadu5>. Complete the form and send it to me (with payment if paying by check/cash or without payment if you want me to send you an email with an online link to make a credit card payment online). Once the club has your payment, I will email or text you that your new trailer sticker is available for you in the clubhouse (usually behind the bar in a labeled envelope for you). Don't wait until it's too late and the Fleet Captain puts a lock on your trailer until you fill out the form and make payment. ;)

Also a reminder for those with new boats since you completed your Seasonal Dock Application way back at the start of the year: Please complete a NEW 2026 dock application form and email it to me (ssh.gbyctreas@gmail.com) with a copy of your new boat insurance Certificate of Insurance. We need to make sure our records of the fleet are correct, that your new boat is properly insured, and that your 2026 dock rental payment is correct. If you got "Two-Foot-More-itis" and your new boat is bigger, there is an increased fee for dock rental (assuming you're over the 25-foot minimum charge).

You can always let me know (via email or text) if you have any questions.

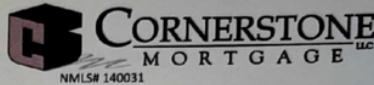
